Language Arts

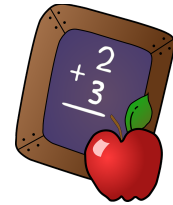
In Language Arts, we are studying author's purpose. We will have a Check-Up on this Friday. We are also finishing our novel study of A Lion to Guard Us. Next Tuesday, the students will have their first Reading Benchmark. Results will be sent home.



In writing, we are working on generating ideas and developing characters so that we can write a realistic fiction story.

Math

We are currently exploring patterns - both repeating and growing. We have started with identifying the pattern rule and extending the pattern. We are working with both geometric and numeric patterns. We are also reviewing the skills of estimation and finding equality in number sentences. We continue to use many different strategies to problems solve different type of real world word problems.
